

CAMPUS POLICIES

Hands Free Campus: We will strive to have a hands free campus. Of course, there should be no “angry hands” on each other, but additionally, there should be no PDA between student couples while on campus.

Electronics: Phones should be used on a limited basis and should be put away during class time. Students and teachers/assistants are expected to be fully engaged during class.

Attendance: Shared Learning is NOT a drop off program. Parents/Guardians must remain on campus for the duration of the event.
